McLaren Park Trail Connector Project

At this meeting, we will review plans for entryway improvements at 3 entrances: Campbell Ave, Visitacion Ave Fire Road and Persia Ave. The work will be completed in early 2014, and the public will be invited to participate in a community planting day. Your input is important and will help us to improve McLaren Park in a way that is most beneficial to the community. Please note that these improvements precede more extensive trail improvements at McLaren Park that will be funded by the 2013 Clean and Safe Neighborhood Parks Bond, for which we will conduct separate outreach.
