

Existing Conditions



Scope of Work

- Extend level area with space for portable toilets, food tents, food trucks, and/or performance equipment; add retaining wall
- Pave access route to backstage area
- Add markers for temporary fencing at hillside
- Cosmetic upgrades to green rooms and increase storage capacity for performers

Feedback Received from May 2019 Community Meeting

Additional Amenities:

- Add shade at stage and amphitheater seating
- Improve lighting and potable water access in green rooms
- Install new refrigerator


Circulation/Signage:

- Relocate bulletin board
- Avoid crowding at food trucks/toilets
- Add more signage at Shelley Drive and Parking Lot

Site Improvements

- Investigate permeable paving options
- Drainage issues on stage

Scope of Work




1. Restripe and provide ADA signage in existing accessible parking area.



2. Expand paving near existing restrooms to accommodate portable toilets.



3. Expand hardscape to accommodate food trucks. (22' to 24' length)



4. Upgrade and relocate existing drinking fountain to be ADA compliant.

Scope of Work



5. Pave existing dirt path to greenrooms.



6. Improve handrails at existing ramp to be ADA compliant.



7. New interior paint at greenrooms



8. New partition/gate at storage room for improved vendor storage.

Scope of Work



9. Renovate ground level ADA seating at amphitheater to be ADA complaint.



10. Define edge at upper limits of the amphitheater to accommodate temporary fencing.

- Increase usability of space for events





