Meeting Minutes

1. Possible terracing of SW area for small dog play area in the future. Plan irrigation with this in mind.
2. Directional signs & temporary lighting (or glow-in-the-dark paint) for safety during construction.
3. High wear at the center of the dog run lawn area.
4. Possible to keep the tennis courts open during construction?
5. Add more benches. (This is not a possible scope for this project due to funding constraints.)
6. Preference for understory plantings, rather than no-mow grass.
7. Consider special events, such as the flea market and children's activities adjacent to the playground. (Noted that no-mow grass can be walked on and therefore appropriate for flea market use.)
8. Landscape selection should establish character/identity for the park.
9. Lay out an informal trail on the slope behind the children's play area.

Next Steps: By general community consensus, the conceptual landscape plan is supported. The next step in the planning process is a presentation to the Recreation and Park Commission for adoption. This is a two-step approval process that includes a presentation on August 4, and final action on August 15.
