



FACILITY RULES

1. All patrons entering the facility during Recreational/Lap Swim times are required to pay the facility admission fee. Parents wishing to watch their children that are 48" in height or taller during recreation swim are not required to pay the adult admission fee, but must remain in the designated spectator area.
2. Persons under the influence of alcohol or narcotics will be denied admission and/or asked to leave the premises.
3. Emergency procedures must be observed. Swimmers must leave the pool area immediately upon the signal or request of the Pool Manager/Lifeguard.
4. If a child is 5 years old or younger, they may accompany a parent into the locker room of opposite sex.
5. Animals are not allowed in the building or pool area, with the exception of guide/service dogs. Guide/service dogs are allowed on deck, but not in the water and must not interfere with the program.
6. If you have had active diarrhea in the last 14 days, please do not enter the pool.
7. Children not potty trained must wear a swim diaper while in the water.
8. All patrons must shower before entering the pool. Persons with open cuts, sores, bandages, colds, coughs or infected eyes are not permitted in the pool.
9. Persons in the water must wear appropriate swim suits. Cotton T-shirts and cutoffs are not allowed. A tight rash guard and modest swimwear is acceptable.
10. Children under 48" in height must be accompanied by a parent or responsible adult in a swim suit at all times including in the water, on the deck and in the restroom. While in the water, the parent/responsible adult must remain within arm's reach at all times.
11. Everyone must pass a swim test before entering deep water. Weak or non-swimmers must remain in shallow water no deeper than their armpits.
12. Inflatable floatation devices (water wings, swim suits with floats etc.) are not allowed. Toys, snorkels and masks are not allowed unless part of organized activity or approved by the Pool Manager. Lifejackets must be U.S. Coast Guard approved.
13. Candy, food or beverages are not allowed except in designated areas provided for eating or drinking. Glass items, chewing gum or smoking are not permitted in the facility.
14. Dangerous practices are prohibited. Diving in shallow water, dunking, pushing, pulling and general behavior infringing on enjoyment of other patrons is not allowed. Jumps are permitted feet first. Back jumps, twisting and flips are not permitted at any time.
15. Foul or abusive language will not be tolerated.
16. Walk at all times DO NOT RUN.
17. All rules and requests made by Pool Staff must be followed.



POOL DECK RULES

1. All patrons must shower before entering the pool. Persons with open cuts, sores, bandages, colds, coughs or infected eyes are not permitted in the pool.
2. Persons in the water must wear appropriate swim suits. Cotton T-shirts and cutoffs are not allowed. A tight rash guard and modest swimwear is acceptable.
3. Children under 48" in height must be accompanied by a parent or responsible adult in a swim suit at all times including in the water, on the deck and in the restroom. While in the water, the parent/responsible adult must remain within arm's reach at all times.
4. Everyone must pass a swim test before entering deep water. Weak or non-swimmers must remain in shallow water no deeper than their armpits.
5. Inflatable floatation devices (water wings, swim suits with floats etc.) are not allowed. Toys, snorkels and masks are not allowed unless part of organized activity or approved by the Pool Manager. Lifejackets must be U.S. Coast Guard approved.
6. Candy, food or beverages are not allowed except in designated areas provided for eating or drinking. Glass items, chewing gum or smoking are not permitted in the facility.
7. Dangerous practices are prohibited. Diving in shallow water, dunking, pushing, pulling and general behavior infringing on enjoyment of other patrons is not allowed. Jumps are permitted feet first. Back jumps, twisting and flips are not permitted at any time.
8. Foul or abusive language will not be tolerated.
9. Walk at all times DO NOT RUN.
10. All rules and requests made by Pool Staff must be followed.
